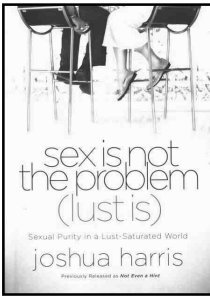
# Men's Ministry

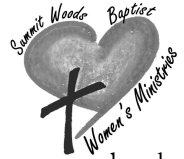
# Women's Ministry
